Information that may be required of you

We may collect and process the following data about you:

To obtain certain financial products you will be asked to submit details or fill in forms on our website. In relation to this it may be relevant or even required of us due to the provision of service we undertake to store your information. This could include anything from the details you provide initially or financial information; we may also need to ask you a few details in case of an error with the site.

In relation to contact with our customers, we may keep a record of discussions/emails that have taken place. We may also ask for details of your visits to the site. This could be relation to location, communication or traffic data that you access but it may not be limited to this. We may ask you to help us in collecting feedback, by filling in surveys that can be used for research and amendment purposes.

It may be valuable to us as a company to carry details of your transactions when you are purchasing on our site. Transactions are co-ordinated by our third party partners as either an intermediary partner or a broker or in contrast; directly to a provider - for example a mortgage outlet.

All information that has been gathered and processed will only remain on file until it is deemed to be insufficient. The maximum time span we will keep your records on file will be 10 years.

Where do we store your personal data records?

- Your personal information may be stored in a region outside of the European economic area (EEA)
- Such an operation may be initiated by staff outside of the EEA who either work for us or one of the third party suppliers you get in contact with when you access our site

Cookies

We use cookies in order to identify registered users and to portray the appropriate pages. We do not permit cookies from third parties on the site, nor do we pass on data derived from cookies to third parties except as provided in our privacy policy.

Statistical information

We gather data on visitors to the site and process it for statistical reasons. Some of this information may relate to you such as how often you visit the site and how you use it. We do this in order to provide an efficient service which is reliable pleasant and helpful to use for all users.

The use and security of your data

We collect the personal data that you may volunteer while using our services. Without limitation, any of the following Data may be collected:

- IP address (automatically collected);

Our use of data

- to communicate with you;

- contact for market research purposes which may be done using email, telephone, fax or mail. Such information may be used to customise or update the Web Site;
